### **APPOINTMENT OF NEW CHIEF EXECUTIVE**

KUALA LUMPUR, 27 February 2025 – Genting Plantations Berhad (“GENP”) announces planned leadership transition, reinforcing its commitment to continuously build an empowered and dynamic organisation.
